A True Testnet for Human Presence

A regulator-facing explanation of the Human Blockchain proof-of-presence environment and its intended May 17, 2030 go-live decision point.

CURRENT STATE	INTENDED DECISION DATE
Controlled behavioral testnet No spendable XP. No customer deposits.	May 17, 2030 Go live only if readiness gates are satisfied.

PURPOSE

To let governments, regulators, researchers, institutions, and communities observe how voluntary presence, delivery, acceptance, dispute, reconciliation, and maturity behave before any proposed live network is considered.

Plain-language position

This testnet records behavioral evidence. It does not accept deposits, custody funds, issue convertible value, promise returns, or claim Federal Reserve, BIS, governmental, or banking status.

1 What makes this a true testnet

The environment is operational rather than merely conceptual: registered devices initiate defined events, a second device confirms or rejects them, system constraints are evaluated, and the result enters an append-only lifecycle. The testnet exists to expose errors, behavioral patterns, privacy risks, governance tensions, duplicate-award attempts, and reconciliation needs before a go-live decision.

The three QR doorways

Identity, YAM-is-On Trade, and Seeking Gratitude enter one proof-of-presence pipeline. QR type remains metadata; it does not create three different currencies or XP classes.

The Y/Y/Y proof

A first scan creates a pending event. Issuance occurs only when delivery is confirmed, acceptance is confirmed, and the encounter requirements are valid.

Fixed study controls

YAM-is-On	\$30	Expected trade-value reference; any genuine fiscal activity remains in WooCommerce and outside XP.
Seeking Gratitude	\$30-equivalent	Never-money XP comparison label; no cash value, conversion, redemption, or payment obligation.
Experience Presence	1 sextillion XP	Recognition for one confirmed proof; stored as behavioral data, not a financial balance.

Other models may compete with or challenge these controls, but they may not reprice an active study position, rewrite historical proof, alter the original maturity date, or convert Seeking Gratitude XP into money.

2 What the testnet does - and does not do

THE TESTNET DOES	THE TESTNET DOES NOT
- Record pseudonymous device-presence events - Preserve timestamped, append-only status changes - Test two-device delivery and acceptance - Test duplicate prevention and dispute handling - Compare fixed behavioral-study controls - Permit participation, observation, or walking away	- Accept or hold customer deposits - Maintain spendable wallet balances - Issue currency, securities, or convertible virtual value - Promise yield, repayment, appreciation, or redemption - Provide banking or money-transmission services - Claim Section 25A, Federal Reserve, BIS, or government authority

Why Section 25A and BIS appear in the vocabulary

Section 25A of the Federal Reserve Act is the Edge Act and applies to specially organized international banking corporations. Human Blockchain does not claim to operate under it. The reference is inspirational only: it points to disciplined separation of undertakings, records, authorities, and risks. BIS 2.0 means Bounty for Inspirational Service. It is a project concept for a long-horizon, gratitude-only presence instrument, not a claim of connection with the Bank for International Settlements.

The governing boundary	Gratitude may accumulate without limit. Money may arise only through a separately documented, legally recognized transaction in a separate fiscal system. If future functionality begins to substitute value for currency, transmit value, take deposits, offer securities, extend credit, or create enforceable monetary claims, that functionality must pause for classification, licensing, and authorization analysis before activation.
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Data protection and participant choice

MINIMIZE	PSEUDONYMIZE	SEPARATE	HONOR CHOICE
Collect only data required to validate the defined encounter.	Keep public records and reporting separate from raw device identifiers.	Keep XP, WooCommerce fiscal records, and Discord governance references distinct.	A no-scan or walk-away decision creates no device-level proof and no character judgment.

Practicing FAITH governs interpretation: Fair, Accepting, Insightful, Transparent, and Humble. Correlation may be studied; motive, character, or causation is not presumed.

3 May 17, 2030: intended go-live decision

May 17, 2030 is the intended activation date for a future live phase, not a representation that authorization has already been obtained. The date creates a transparent planning horizon. It does not override law, licensing, examination, contractual consent, technical readiness, or public-interest review.

1	Legal classification	Written analysis of payments, money transmission, deposits, lending, securities, commodities, consumer protection, tax, nonprofit, research, and applicable state-law questions.
2	Technical assurance	Independent security review; ledger integrity; access controls; idempotent issuance; incident response; backup, recovery, and reconciliation testing.
3	Privacy and research	Data inventory; minimization; notice and consent; retention schedule; participant rights; research ethics or IRB review where applicable.
4	Governance readiness	Defined authority for Individual, POC, and Guild roles; transparent dispute and correction procedures; conflicts management; audit access.
5	Fiscal separation	Demonstrated separation of XP from WooCommerce, banking, tax, settlement, and any other monetary system; no implied convertibility.
6	Regulatory engagement	Relevant agencies and professional advisers receive an accurate description, requested information, and a meaningful opportunity to raise objections before activation.

All applicable gates supported by evidence and approvals.	Only specifically reviewed nonmonetary functions activate; restricted functions remain disabled.	Material legal, privacy, security, governance, or authorization gaps remain.

4 Invitation to governments and regulators

Human Blockchain invites early scrutiny so the testnet can reveal what must be corrected before 2030. Engagement does not imply endorsement. Any organization may review, question, observe, propose safeguards, decline participation, or request correction of a statement about it.

REQUESTED REVIEW	QUESTIONS FOR THE TESTNET
Regulatory perimeter	Which current or proposed functions would cross a licensing, registration, examination, disclosure, or authorization boundary?
Consumer understanding	Would a reasonable participant clearly understand that XP is nonspendable, nonconvertible, and never money?
Privacy and records	Is the metadata necessary, proportionate, securely retained, and appropriately separated from public reporting?
Governance	Are authority, dispute, correction, reconciliation, audit, and no-go powers sufficiently clear and independent?
2030 readiness	What evidence must be produced, and which functions must remain disabled, before any live activation is considered?

Proposed timeline

Instrument the testnet, document controls, test consent and privacy, and collect behavioral evidence.	Publish findings, conduct independent reviews, test reconciliation, and maintain restricted nonmonetary scope.	Final reconciliation and go/no-go evidence package; unresolved gates remain visible.	Intended live-phase decision and activation only for functions supported by applicable approvals and readiness evidence.
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The intended outcome	A transparent answer by May 17, 2030: what may responsibly go live, what must remain a test, and what must not proceed. Presence is the evidence. Consent is the boundary. Practicing FAITH is the covenant.
